

3 Simple Photography Rules by Mike McLean

- 1.** FILL THE FRAME.
If your photo isn't good enough, then you're not close enough.
- 2.** CONTROL YOUR BACKGROUND.
You can change proximity or angle to the subject to remove distracting background. Or adjust aperture for shallow depth of field.
- 3.** SHOOT GREAT MOMENTS.
Looking for the picture that tells the entire high school experience. It's a moment, a reaction - avoid scatter shooting...be deliberate in choosing subject matter.
