

Bluebeard Retouching Lesson

Lesson on using the “Healing” family tools:

Spot Healing Brush - for small, instant fixes

Healing Brush - using opt+click on good skin to fix bad blemishes

Patch Tool - for healing Big, Bad Spots

To use the Spot Healing Brush simply make the brush an equal size to blemish and click or paint it away.

To use the Healing Brush, opt+click on good skin that matches area you are fixing, then click or paint on blemish.

To use Patch Tool, draw a circle around big blemish, then move entire circle to area of good skin that matches and click.

When fixing the eye, use the Healing Brush. First go to Window and chose Clone Source. When the dialog box appears, enter a subtraction symbol in front of the number on the direction you are flipping (vertical/horizontal). Make sure the brush is big enough to get ALL the eye in without too much extra. Then Opt+click. Go to other eye, in correct space, and click!

DO NOT make skin look fake or retouched. It should have no definitive lines, or waxy look to it.

You can get rid of some wrinkles and beard, if you choose to. Just make it natural!
