

# **Create Black & White Photos with a Pop of Color**

**Here are two ways you can create a black & white photo and bring back one color to make the photo pop!**

## **#1 - Using Hue/Saturation with History Brush**

- Bring photo into photoshop**
- Go to Image > Adjustments > Hue/Saturation**
- Drag the levels all the way to the left**
- You should now have black & white**
- Next click on the History Brush**
- Being incredibly careful on the size of the brush, paint back the color**

## **#2 - Using Adjustment Palette with the Paint Brush**

- Bring photo into photoshop**
- Click on the black/white icon in the adjustment panel**
- You should now have a black & white photo**
- Now Click on the Paint Brush**
- Being very careful of brush size, erase the black & white on the object you want to bring back color on.**
- If you make a mistake, switch the color and erase the mistake (I'll show in class)**

**\*\*Shortcut to make brush bigger/smaller - use your brackets!**
